

## **Update of Contact Details**

In preparation for the appointment of a new Priest in Charge for Ashbourne Group of Churches we wish to update the contact details we hold for everyone connected with all churches in the Group. This will help the induction of our new incumbent once they are appointed.

In order for us to update these details we are asking everyone connected to St Oswald's Ashbourne and St Mary's Mappleton to complete the Contact Form overleaf and return it by handing it to a Church Warden or placing in one of the boxes provided in each church, by **31st March 2025**.

The information collected on the forms will be treated confidentially and stored securely in the church database known as iKnow Church, for the use of the officers of the church to enable effective communication within the parish.

## **Preparation of New Electoral Roll**

In accordance with the Church Representation Rules (CRR), 2025 is a year in which an entirely new church Electoral Roll must be prepared in advance of the Annual Parochial Church Meeting, in every parish in the Church of England. The Electoral Roll is the list of all those who want to be considered part of St Oswald's or St Mary's, worshipping there regularly, and also allows you to take part in the Annual Meeting or stand for election to the Parochial Church Council. The APCM for St Oswald's Ashbourne with St Mary Mappleton will be held **on 6**<sup>th</sup> **April 2025** so the new electoral roll will be prepared in March 2025.

Whether or not a person has their name entered on the existing electoral roll, **everyone** wishing to be enrolled on the new roll must complete a fresh form of application.

Application forms for those who wish to be enrolled will be available in each of the churches during the rest of February and early March 2025. Completed forms should be placed in the boxes provided in each church for the purpose and must be submitted **by 9**<sup>th</sup> **March 2025.** 

If you do complete an application form, please do consider giving us your email address as it makes our communication with you easier and cheaper.

Being a member of Electoral Roll brings with it some responsibilities including being part of the church community.
